

TUSCOLA COUNTY ELECTION NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the General Election will be held in Tuscola County on
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2024

TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS: Of the Tuscola County Townships of Akron, Almer Charter, Arbela, Columbia, Dayton, Denmark, Elkland, Ellington, Elmwood, Fairgrove, Fremont, Gilford, Indianfields, Juniata, Kingston, Koylton, Millington, Novesta, Tuscola, Vassar, Watertown, Wells, Wisner and the Cities of Caro and Vassar, State of Michigan:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the following office and proposals will appear on the ballot:

ALL JURISDICTIONS - OFFICES THAT WILL APPEAR ON THE AUGUST 6, 2024 PRIMARY ELECTION BALLOT

Candidates of the Democratic Party, Republican Party, Libertarian Party, U.S. Taxpayers Party, Green Party, Working Class Party, Natural Law Party, and candidates without political party affiliation seeking election to the following partisan offices are to be voted for: Electors of President and Vice-President of the United States, US Senator, Representative in Congress, State Representative, Member of the State Board of Education, Regent of the University of Michigan, Trustee of Michigan State University, Governor of Wayne State University, County Offices of Prosecuting Attorney, Sheriff, Clerk, Treasurer, Register of Deeds, Road Commissioner, Drain Commissioner, County Commissioner and Township Offices of Supervisor, Clerk, Treasurer, Trustee and such other partisan offices that may by law be required to be filled at this election.

Candidates seeking election to the following non-partisan offices are to be voted for: Justice of Supreme Court, Judge of Court of Appeals 4th District, Judge of 54th Circuit Court, Judge of Probate Court, Local School Board Members, City Mayor, City Council Member, Village Offices of President and Trustee, Library Board Members and such other non-partisan offices that may by law be required to be filled at this election.

PROPOSALS THAT WILL APPEAR ON THE NOVEMBER 5, 2024 BALLOT

DAYTON TOWNSHIP - ROAD MILLAGE INCREASE PROPOSAL

Shall the 15 mill tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within Dayton Township be increased by an additional one mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for the period of four years, 2025 through 2028 inclusive, for the sole and exclusive purpose of repair and maintenance of roads within Dayton Township and shall Township be authorized to levy such additional millage for the said purpose? Approval of this millage will raise a first year estimated total \$68,166.00.

DENMARK TOWNSHIP - TOWNSHIP OPERATING EXPENSES

Shall Denmark Township impose an increase of up to 0.50 mills (\$0.50 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution on General Ad Valorem Taxes within Denmark Township and levy it for ten (10) years, 2024 through 2033 inclusive, for general township operating purposes, which a 0.50 mill increase will raise an estimated \$62,943.20 in the first year the millage is levied.

ELMWOOD TOWNSHIP - FIRE MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall the previously authorized increase in tax limitation on all taxable property in the Township of Elmwood, Tuscola County, that expired in 2023 be renewed and the Township be authorized to levy annually an amount not to exceed 1.2424 mills (\$1.2424 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), for five (5) years, 2024 to 2028 inclusive, to provide funds for operating, equipping, providing personnel, and purchasing for the fire department or any other purpose authorized by law for fire service purposes? The estimate of the revenue the Township will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Township in the first year (2024) is approximately \$62,000.

JUNIATA TOWNSHIP - ROAD MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall Juniata Township, County of Tuscola, State of Michigan, be authorized to levy annually an amount not to exceed 2.9829 mills (\$2.9829 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a renewal of the previously authorized millage rate that expires in 2024, against all taxable property within the Township for a period of six (6) years, 2025 to 2030, inclusive, for the purpose of constructing, preserving, improving, repairing, and maintaining roads, bridges, and ditches in the Township? The estimate of the revenue the Township will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Township in the first year (2025) is approximately \$290,000. Funds from this millage may be used by the Township to provide services to Township residents by contract with the Tuscola County Road Commission.

KOYLTON TOWNSHIP - RENEWAL FOR IMPROVEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF ROADS PROPOSAL

Shall the previously voted increase in the 15 mill tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6, of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within Koylton Township be renewed at 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1000.00 of taxable value) for the period of 2 years, 2025 through 2026 inclusive, for the sole and exclusive purpose of the improvement and maintenance of roads within Koylton Township and shall the Township levy such renewal millage for the said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$90,000.00?

OWENDALE-GAGETOWN AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT - OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL EXEMPTING PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE AND OTHER PROPERTY EXEMPTED BY LAW 18 MILLS FOR 10 YEARS

REESE UNITY DISTRICT LIBRARY – LIBRARY MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall the Reese Unity District Library, Counties of Saginaw and Tuscola, be authorized to levy a millage annually in an amount not to exceed .9965 mills (\$.9965 per \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a renewal of the millage rate that expires in 2024, against all taxable property within the Reese Unity District Library district for a period of ten (10) years, 2025 to 2034, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the Reese Unity District Library will collect in the first year of levy (2025) if the millage is approved and levied by the District Library is approximately \$286,000.
