

MINUTES OF ARBELA TOWNSHIP REGULAR MONTHLY BOARD MEETING

May 13, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Joe White at 6:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL: Present ó Mary Warren, Jody Hunt, Wayne Schultz, William Jacobi, Joseph White, Commissioner Jensen, Deputy Glumm and 6 residents.

MOTION: By Jody Hunt to approve the minutes of the April 8, 2019, township board meeting.

MOTION: By Mary Warren to pay bills and payroll.

Supervisor White gave the fire board report. There was 3 structure fires, 2 grass fires, 1 other fire, 0 Power line standbys, 1 mutual aid, 3 motor vehicle/pedestrian accidents, 3 misc. call, 1 false alarm and 30 E.M.S responses.

Deputy Glumm gave the police report. There were 4 tickets issued, 57 property inspections, 30 vehicles investigated, 38 persons investigated, 1 paper served and 2 assists to other departments.

Supervisor White gave a road update. The road commission is in the process of grading the gravel roads. They replaced the tube on Currier Road and it is now open.

MOTION: By Jody Hunt to to approve the funeral dinner policy as follows:
When a township resident is deceased the family can schedule a funeral dinner at the Arbela Township Hall during the week of passing or the following week in case the arrangements are scheduled that way. The hall is free to residents with such a need, but the family will still have to provide the proper insurance coverage plus \$150.00 deposit. The township also requests the dinner concludes by 7:00 p.m. and cleanup is the renter's responsibility. In case the hall is unscheduled for Saturday of that time period the family may request the hall's use for their family dinner. Again, the township requests the dinner concludes by 7:00 p.m. However, if the hall is rented then the rental will take priority. In rare instances and on a case by case the hall may be free to a township resident's family scheduling a family memorial dinner in the future. These dinners may be held during the week and during normal business hours if the hall is not rented. Please contact the township for details.
