There were 0 structure fires, 0 grass fires, 1 other fire, 2 automobile/pedestrian accidents, 0 Power line standby, 1 mutual aid, 6 motor vehicle/pedestrian accidents, 5 misc. calls, 0 false alarm and 15 E.M.S responses. The chassis for the new fire truck is finished and on its way to South Dakota. Our share of the chassis ws \$35,290.00. The fire board is working on a plan for turn out gear. How much we have and how much we will have to purchase each year to stay current. Sharon has applied for a grant for turn out gear.

Deputy Glumm gave the police report. There was 1 arrests, 10 tickets issued, 26 property inspections, 15 vehicles investigated, 17 persons investigated, 0 paper served and 0 assists to other departments. There were 2 assaults, 1 burglary, 2 fraud, 1 larceny, 2 child neglect, 3 resisting arrest, 3 accidents, 1 false alarm, 6 inspections, 10 misc., and 0 assist to other police agency.

Tim Anderson sent out three letters to residents in violation of the Rubbish Control Ordinance.

Supervisor White gave a road update. The Road Commission has agreed to hold off paving Swaffer Road until next year. They did asphalt Stanley Drive and spread gravel on various roads in the township.
